Spring 2022 Matt, Big Al and Conner Return

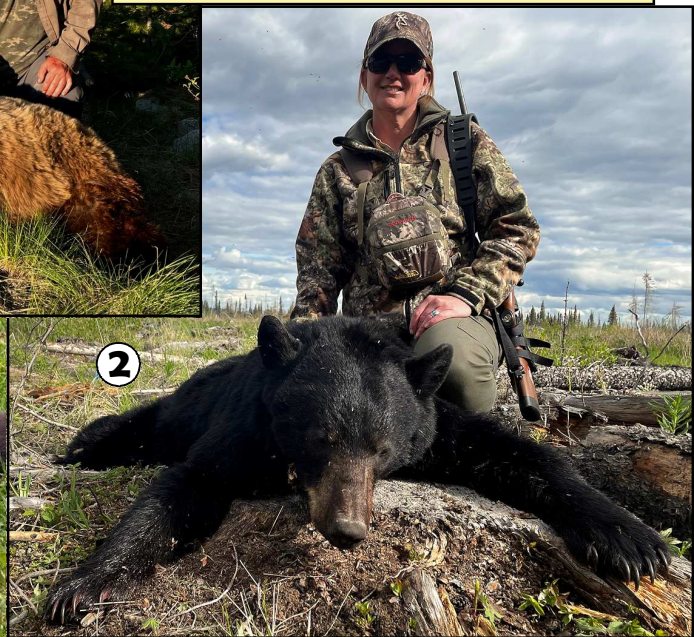
The border didn't open again until August 2021. So our first proper spring bear season was in 2022.

Spring 2023

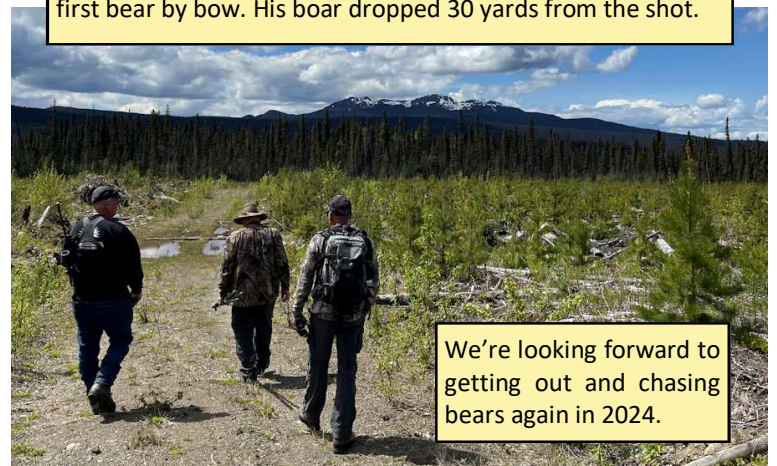
Record Breaker



Spring 2023 was a bit of a change from 2022, in that all our hunters were hunting with us for the first time.

Erik (1) from WA is a champion target shooter and he came prepared to shoot fast and far. But as it turned out, he stalked and killed his first black bear at a mere 20 yards. Erik's buddy Joe killed a good bear earlier in the hunt. But Joe's second bear (2) was this scarred-up monster that measured a whopping 7'8". Joe's bear became the third bear in 3 years that each broke the previous Omineca record. Wes 7'6" 2020. Matt 7'7" 2022 and now Joe 7'8" 2023.

Up from California, Bret (4) and his son Noah (3) had a great hunt. Noah killing his first black bear and his Dad whacked his first bear by bow. His bear dropped 30 yards from the shot.



We're looking forward to getting out and chasing bears again in 2024.
